8. To consider provision of an additional Dog Bin in the vicinity of Searles View and Treadcroft Drive

Horsham District Council has now provided details of the potential costs in installing and maintaining a new dog bin in this location. To purchase a new bin is £340 with installation being an additional £40, and a charge of £2.35 per emptying, which is typically once per week.

The Parish Council can request HDC to monitor the location for a four week period to assess whether there is a need for this, and if they determine that there is, they will install and maintain the bin at their cost. If, however, HDC deem it unnecessary, the Parish Council can choose to fund the installation and emptying themselves.
