FC/290/18 Public Forum

There were no members of the public in attendance.

FC/291/18 Apologies for absence

The Council received apologies and reasons for absence from Cllr R. Knight, Cllr R. Millington and Cllr I. Wassell.

FC/292/18 Minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 6th September 2018 were agreed and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

FC/293/18 Declarations of interest

Cllr K. Burgess and Cllr P. Burgess declared a prejudicial interest part way through item FC/300/18 as their son is a Caretaker for North Horsham Parish Council.

FC/294/18 Committees and Working Parties

The following Committee Minutes were presented to Council: -

It was RESOLVED that the Committee Minutes listed above be received and adopted.

FC/295/18 Reports from representatives on outside bodies.

The Council received notes from the Horsham Park Management Planning Landscape/Ecology Focus group held on 11.10.2018 which had been

circulated to all Councillors previously.

Cllr Searle reported that he had attended a recent meeting of the Brookhurst Wood Landfill Site Liaison Group (BIFFA). The large-scale mechanical biological treatment (MBT) plant, designed to recover 40% of the Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF), is currently running at between 50 -56%. The landfill site has been capped and restoration of the site is scheduled to be finished by 2023. Currently tipping is taking place in the old access road to bring it to its final level. Biffa has submitted a planning application to West Sussex County Council (WSCC) to demolish the disused kiln that is on the site. MBT received 48,184 tonnes of house hold waste between July - September 2018 and baled and wrapped 7906 to take off site.

Cllr Searle had attended the Weineberger Liaison Group. Brick production had hit its target for 2018 and all bricks that have been manufactured had been sold, consequently their stocks were low.

Cllr Searle will attend the Brittaniacrest Liaison Group next Monday when there should be more information on the proposed incinerator for their Langhurstwood Road site which had been refused permission by WSCC.

FC/296/18 Reports from District or County Councillor

Horsham District Councillor Roy Cornell informed the Parish Council that Horsham District Council (HDC) Officers had written to Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust regarding land adjacent to 78 Crawley Road and been advised that there are embryonic plans to use the area for a National Health Service (NHS) medical unit. It was believed that the land had been given to the people of Roffey by the NHS and that it may be an area where affordable housing would give significant benefit to the parish in the future. It was suggested that the Parish Council may consider purchasing the land and forming a Community Land Trust to bring the idea of more affordable housing in the parish to fruition.

The Planning, Environment and Transport Committee had considered concerns raised by a resident regarding the junction of Manor Fields and Harwood Road. Traffic leaving Manor Fields and turning right towards Horsham had restricted sightlines and the traffic flow is often heavy and travelling at considerable speed. The Planning Committee had agreed to write to WSCC Highways outlining the concerns and West Sussex County Cllr Andrew Baldwin would be copied into the letter.

Concern was raised regarding speeding on Rusper Road and enquiries made about a Speed watch initiative previously organised by the Police.

The Clerk had made enquiries and the information would be circulated to Councillors.

West Sussex County Cllr Andrew Baldwin reported that WSCC were facing serious funding cuts as their grant from government had reduced by £145,000,000 since 2010/11. Whilst WSCC had made savings of £216,000,000 during that time, they still need to find savings of over £100,000,000 over the next four years. This would obviously have a knock on effect to the services that can be provided. This was particularly evident where Traffic Restriction Orders (TRO) were concerned, as Cllr Baldwin had received eight requests for support so far this year, but only three TROs a year are allowed with a maximum spend on each one of £3,000.

Temporary gas works on Crawley Road have caused another road closure in close proximity to the recent three months road closure required to relay gas pipes. The gas pipe laying work has not yet been completed.

A traffic calming scheme suggested by residents of Lambs Farm Road has been refused by WSCC. Throughout the county there were 60 applications and only 12 accepted. One of the reasons being that there have only been five recorded accidents in the road in 5 years involving personal injury. The Parish Council's Planning, Environment and Transport Committee has agreed to submit a TRO for additional yellow lines on the junctions of Lambs Farm Road, Morrell Avenue, Farhalls Crescent and Rough Way and will hold a site meeting to discuss what would be most appropriate request. West Sussex County Cllr. Andrew Baldwin would be invited to the meeting.

West Sussex County Cllr Liz Kitchen reported that Colgate Parish Council was still pursuing a 40mph speed limit along the whole of Forest Road. Money is available to local community groups through the Community Initiative Fund.

There is a consultation on the Gatwick master plan with local exhibitions planned. The Planning, Environment and Transport Committee will consider their response to the plan at their next meeting. Residents of Durrants Village have put forward a plan to upgrade Faygate railway station as a cheaper alternative to creating two new railway stations at North Horsham and Kilnwood Vale.

FC/297/18 Chairman's announcements

The Chairman had accepted an invitation to lay a poppy wreath at All Saints Church Roffey on behalf of the residents in North Horsham parish on Remembrance Sunday, 11th November 2018. This year commemorates 100 years since the end of World War 1.

Appreciation was expressed for notes circulated by Cllr J Gough following her attendance at the South East Community Led Housing Conference led by Action in Rural Sussex. Cllr P. Burgess was also in attendance at the Conference.

FC/298/18 Financial matters

- 1. The Parish Council AGREED the payment schedule to 30th September 2018 for £42,238.25. (attached).
- 2. The Council AGREED to minute that the Annual Governance and Accountability Return had been received back from the External Auditor without qualification. This had been reported in detail at the Finance and Administration Committee on 11th October 2018.

FC/299/18 Community Land Trusts

The Council RESOLVED that CIIr J. Davidson, CIIr J. Gough, CIIr J. Smithurst and CIIr R. Turner would form a small working party to commence an initial investigation into setting up a Community Land Trust as a means to having greater control of affordable housing provision in North Horsham parish. The Planning, Environment and Transport Committee will lead the initiative and members of the public that have previously expressed an interest will be invited to join the working party.

FC/300/18 Future pension provision for new caretakers

Cllr K Burgess and Cllr P Burgess declared prejudicial interests and left the meeting completely very shortly after the commencement of the debate.

The Parish Council reviewed information regarding alternative pensions which could be offered to new Caretakers who may come into post in the future. After a lengthy debate, it was AGREED that further information was required and that this item would be taken to both the Finance and Administration Committee and Personnel Committee before being brought back to the full Council.

FC/301/18 Horsham District Council of the Year 2019 Flag

It was AGREED to purchase a Year of Culture flag at a cost of £50.75 and to fly it on the Roffey Millennium Hall flagpole throughout 2019, except on the agreed flag flying days of the Union Flag.

FC/302/18 Policies

The Council RESOLVED to agree and adopt :-

- 1. A Secondary Employment, Volunteering and Political Work Policy, Equal Opportunities Policy, Dignity and Respect at Work Policy, Standards of Behaviour at Work Policy and Pensions Policy recommended by the Personnel Committee.
- 2. An additional clause to the Open Spaces Policy "Metal detecting is not permitted on land owned by the Parish Council unless it is part of an archaeological dig, in which case applications for permission should be made in writing to the Parish Council."
