Prior to the meeting at 7pm the Senior Planning Officer and Principle Planning Officer from Horsham District Council were available to discuss the Strategic Housing Economic and Land Availability Assessment (SHELAA) Housing Land Report.

PET/609/19 Public Forum

There were two members of public present on behalf of residents of Lambs Farm Road, Morrell Avenue, Rough Way and Farhalls Crescent. A Traffic Restriction Order application (see attached) was presented to the committee regarding parking associated with Littlehaven Station.

PET/610/19 Apologies for absence

The Committee received apologies and reasons for absence from Cllr R. Millington, Cllr M. Loates and Cllr Mrs R. Ginn. Cllr Mrs. F. Haigh did not attend and did not give apologies.

PET/611/19 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest given.

PET/612/19 Minutes

The Minutes of the Committee Meeting held on 21st March 2019 were agreed and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

With agreement of the committee item 8 was moved forward to this point in the meeting.

PET/613/19 TRO for Lambs Farm Road

A Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) (see attached) was put forward by residents of Lambs Farm Road, Morrell Avenue, Rough Way and Farhalls Crescent to address concerns regarding parking associated with Littlehaven Station.

It was RESOLVED to support the resident's request for a Traffic Regulation Order application and write to West Sussex County Council and the West Sussex County Councillor for Horsham East. In addition,

the committee resolved to request that a visual plan be forwarded to North Horsham Parish Council to finalise the committee's support.

Both members of public left the meeting.

Chairman's Announcements

1. The Parish Council has been notified that a Road Space Audit is scheduled for Horsham in the future. This is where an independent body assesses the road markings and signs within the town and designated additional areas. WSCC Cllr Andrew Baldwin has asked that the area around Littlehaven Railway Station be included. Road Space Audits can take a long time and the recommendations can include removing road markings and signs as well as commissioning more.
2. Following last month's meeting information has been circulated to all Councillors on the role and remit of Tree Wardens, this includes the Tree Warden's Code of Conduct, The WSCC Tree Warden insurance, Tree Warden's Leaflet, WSCC Tree Warden information, an e-mail from the County Arboriculturist and notification of links to the WSCC website where there is a specific page on 'information for parish councils'.

3. The Parish Council has received a Notification of S278/38 highways agreement at North Horsham, Rusper Roundabout. This is for the construction of a signalised roundabout to replace Rusper Road roundabout on the A264 and the construction of a 4arm roundabout on Rusper Road with a Pegasus crossing. Rusper Parish Council has already responded to draw attention to the omission of traffic calming. This will be raised at the North Horsham Parish Liaison Meeting on 30th May 2019 and a Highways Engineer from WSCC will be invited to the meeting to explain this further.
4. The Planning, Environment and Transport had a budget of £2,250 for 2018/19. The year end figures show a spend of £737 throughout the year. This was broken down to £526.20 for Tree Warden Training and Expenses and £211.10 for a "Cut Your Engine" sign at Littlehaven Station. There remains £8,035 in an Ear Marked Reserve. The budget for 2019/20 is £2,250.
5. Cllr A. Britten notified NHPC that at Horsham District Councils' Full Council meeting held on 24th April 2019 on functions responsibilities and constitution of planning committees at Horsham District Council, HDC agreed, by a vast majority vote, that there would be no constitution changes

to HDC's Planning Committee.

PET/614/19 Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHELAA) 2018 Housing Report

A Horsham District Council Senior Planning Officer and Principle Planning Officer will be coming to speak to the committee to explain and expand on their response to North Horsham Parish Council's initial SHELAA consultation comments. This was held at 7pm prior to this planning meeting.

In indicating its thanks to the District Council officers for attending the meeting and explaining the reasons for the inclusion of sites in the SHELAA, it was RESOLVED to write to Horsham District Council reiterating concerns on the following sites listed in the SHELAA: Roffey Sports and Social Club (SA145), Parsonage Farm (SA144), Land at Newhouse Farm (SA127), Langhurstwood Road (SA444) and all the sites marked as not currently developable north of the Legal and General development (previously Liberty development) (SA363, SA750, SA751).

PET/615/19 Grass verges

West Sussex County has agreed North Horsham Parish Council can use their template letter (see attached) they send out to residents regarding parking on grass verges. As NHPC does not have the resources to carry out this task any future concerns regarding grass verges should be reported to WSCC.

It was RESOLVED to note the current resources available to the Parish Council and to prepare an item to go in the earliest possible edition of the Horsham Pages aiming to prevent parking on grass verges.

PET/616/19 Constitution changes to Horsham District Council's Planning Committee

Cllr A. Britten notified NHPC that at Horsham District Councils' Full Council meeting held on 24th April 2019 on functions responsibilities and constitution of planning committees at Horsham District Council, HDC agreed, by a vast majority vote, that there would be no constitution changes to HDC's Planning Committee.

It was RESOLVED to write to Horsham District Council to invite them to consult Parish Councils on constitution and process changes in the future.

PET/617/19 Professional Support for the hearing for the appeal against WSCC/015/18/NH Wealden Brickworks – Energy from Waste Facility (Incinerator).

Surrey and Sussex Association of Local Councils has suggested a solicitor that offers a junior planning barrister. The cost is difficult to advise as until they have seen the application and understand what representations the

Council wants to make there is little to go on. The MINIMUM cost will be £2,000 plus VAT but of course, this could rise significantly the more work is required.

It was RESOLVED to

1. **Agree to continue to seek professional support to assist representing the Parish Council's stance at the appeal stage.**
2. **To seek support from neighbouring Parish Councils to include; Rusper, Colgate, Warham, Slinfold and Broadbridge Heath.**

PET/618/19 Community Land Trust

It was RESOLVED to invite members of an established Community Land Trusts groups to talk to the CLT working party so that a better understanding of the process and requirements can be gained.
