Temporary closure of A24 Horsham Bypass, Horsham, 9th April 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic A24 Horsham Bypass, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on A24 Southbound for a distance approx 2399.00 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 9th April 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 12th April 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while West Sussex County Council undertakes Night Road Closure between the junctions with Horsham Northern Bypass to Farthings Hill to install temporary barriers and traffic management associated with lane narrowing's for widening works Works being undertaken by Landbuild - 01798 872555

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 20:00 until 06:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
